## Community Profile



Ronceverte, West Virginia, Gateway to the Greenbrier Valley, extends along the Greenbrier River between two of the world's richest limestone bluegrass-agricultural areas: "The Big Levels" of Greenbrier County and the fertile farmlands of Monroe County.

Fort Hill used by the Confederate Troops during the Civil War as an observation post, guards the south gate of a vantage point of 500 ft.

Greenbrier River, said to be "the most beautiful in the world," has a normal flow of one billion gallons of water per day. It's banks are lined with summer camps and homes.

Ronceverte's growth started with a grist mill in 1780. The town "boomed" when the wheels of "The Big Lumber Mill" of The St. Lawrence Boom and Manufacturing Company began to turn in 1883. Today this sight is occupied by B.A. Mullican Lumber and Flooring, carrying on the tradition of wood milling and wood products.

Ronceverte, incorporated 1882, has a reasonable reservoir of skilled and unskilled labor. Responsible City and County governments insure moderate taxes. Rents are extremely reasonable. Climate is ideal and people are friendly and loyal.

Recreational facilities are ideal with our 22 acre Island Park which features a children's playground, four-lane quarter-mile track, swimming pool, basketball courts, horseshoe pits, picnic shelters, ball fields, walking trail, and skateboard park. Our amphitheater hosts the Riders of the Flood outdoor drama each September, as well as the annual River Festival in June. With the Greenbrier River at our doorstep, we also offer swimming, tubing, canoeing and fishing.
